His STORY

Donnie Green was born July 9th, 1954, to the parents of Roosevelt and Cleo Green in Oakland, California. Donnie was also affectionately known as twin. He received his education in the Oakland Unified School district graduating from Oakland Technical High school in 1972. In the year of 1968, Donnie met the love of his life, Melba Buckhalter, and on July 12th, 1975 they were married. To that union three amazing sons were born, Donnie Jr, Donyell and DeAndre Green.

Donnie accepted Christ at an early age, was a member of Humanity Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor Samuel Williams, and Bishop George L. Anderson, who presented Donnie with a certificate of license to share the gospel in December 1993. Donnie continued his membership under the current Pastor, his nephew Pastor Philandrew Miller Jr.
